# EUROPEAN CHARTER FOR TOLERANCE AT EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

Tolerance promotion and the shaping of attitudes of openness, mutual listening and solidarity should take place in schools and universities and through non-formal education, at home and in the workplace. Tolerance is harmony in difference.

1. Education should promote understanding tolerance and friendship among all nations, racial or religion groups.
2. To develop and encourage respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms for all, without distinction as to race, gender, language, national origin, religion or disability, and to combat intolerance.
3. To promote tolerance in our societies, because tolerance is not a cherished principle, but also a necessity for peace, democracy and for the economic and social advancement of all peoples.
4. Education is the most effective means of preventing intolerance. The first step in tolerance education is to teach people what their shared rights and freedoms are, so that they may be respected, and to promote the will to protect those of others.
5. To know and to learn as many languages as possible – the way to tolerance promotion and understanding each other.
6. School communities are to ensure students' awareness not only of their rights but of their duties, too.
7. In order to generate public awareness, emphasize the dangers of intolerance and react with renewed commitment and action in support of tolerance promotion and education, we should commemorate 16 November – the annual International Day for Tolerance.
