managers.

• The jointly improved project plan is the base for the final decision of the contest.

• The sponsored projects will be taking place between May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007, and April 30<sup>th</sup>,

2008. The next round of application will be in spring 2007, deadline for

submission of entries will be on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

• Especially successful projects will be awarded and have the opportunity to present

themselves at a celebration.
